## A Look at Life

Alpha Omega Center wants to reduce the number of unwanted pregnancies and abortions in our community. Once a woman is pregnant, presenting the truth in a supportive environment is often what is needed to head off an abortion. Just as a picture paints

a thousand words, an ultrasound presents a thousand reasons for continuing a pregnancy. Women who have ultrasounds often decide to continue their pregnancies. Valentines Day, 2012 marks the day we performed our first client ultra sound.

Our **New Beginnings** program teaches new moms and dads the skills they need to parent effectively.

Alpha Omega Center strives to help young people avoid mistakes that will haunt them for the rest of their lives by empowering them to make wise choices about their sex lives. Our LifeMatters training presents information about the advantages of abstinence, as well as factual presen-

tations about the risks of STDs, teenage pregnancies, and promiscuous sexual relationships. We also provide them with strategies to help them put their choices into action in the face of peer pressure and hormones.

In 2012 we worked in our three nearest counties. We worked with all eight school districts in Lawrence county, and with four school districts in Mercer county and two school district in Butler county. Our surveys show that after our presentations, up to 39% of students who are not already committed to abstinence either adopt or move towards an abstinence position.



## A Look Ahead



### NC Medical Office

We are currently remodeling our **NC** location to be a medical office. Our nurse sonographer for **NC** has just been certified. We plan to offer ultra sounds in the **NC** office by May 1, 2013.

### STD Testing

We hope to start offering tests for sexually transmitted diseases and infections (STDs) during the 2013 calendar year. This will allow us to interact with men as clients, as well as minister to people who aren't pregnant, but may still need support and help.

### Abortion Vulnerable Clients

We continue our efforts to effectively reach abortion-vulnerable and abortion-minded women in our geographic area. We plan to continue to reach out to the high schools, tech schools, colleges, and universities to let young people know we are here to help them.

### LifeMatters

Our goal is to bring LifeMatter presentations to all the middle and high schools in Butler, Lawrence, and Mercer counties that don't already have abstinence education.
